

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVY AND ASSESSMENT OF TAXES FOR THE DOLTON PARK DISTRICT, COUNTY OF COOK AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING **MAY 1, 2020**, AND ENDING **APRIL 30, 2021**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Dolton Park District, Cook County, Illinois, that the sum of **TWO MILLION, SEVENTY-EIGHT, SIX HUNDRED AND 60/100 (\$2,078,600.60)**, being the total of the appropriations heretofore legally made which are to be collected from the tax levy of the current fiscal year for the Dolton Park District, Cook County, Illinois, for all corporate purposes of said Dolton Park District, Cook County, Illinois as appropriated for the current fiscal year by the Board of Park Commissioners of the Dolton Park District for the fiscal year beginning **May 1, 2020**, and ending **April 30, 2021** as passed by the Board of Park Commissioners of the Dolton Park District at its meeting of **December 8, 2020** and assessed on all taxable property within the Dolton Park District and subject to taxation for the current fiscal year. The objects and purposes and the respective amounts hereby levied in the aggregate sum of **TWO MILLION, SEVENTY-EIGHT, SIX HUNDRED AND 60/100 (\$2,078,600.60)**, as follows:



SECTION I: That the taxes herein levied are for the Corporate Fund, Recreation Program Fund, Insurance Program, Social Security Benefits, IMRF, Bonds, Unemployment Insurance, Municipal Audit, Programs for Special Recreation Services and Park Security be in addition to all other authorized taxes.

SECTION II: That the Secretary of the Dolton Park District shall make and file with the County Clerk of the Cook County, Illinois, a duly certified copy of this ordinance, and she shall certify to said County Clerk that the amount levied and assessed by this taxation as aforesaid to be extended upon the appropriate tax books for the fiscal year beginning **May 1, 2020** and ending **April 30, 2021** and is required by said Park District to be so levied and assessed and extended upon the appropriate tax books for the fiscal year beginning **May 1, 2020** and ending **April 30, 2021**.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, and the same shall remain so from and after its passage and approval, and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.




